Absent Ken Carda. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion Shrader, second Neumayer to approve agenda as posted. Motion carried. Motion Neumayer, second Shrader to approve financial report as presented. Motion carried. Motion Shrader, second Neumayer to approve Sept. 6 and Sept 11 (special mtg) as published. Motion carried. Motion Bares, second Shrader to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

DELEGATION: Alvin and Ruth Sternhagen (Kortan Hatwan) requested information as SD Dept. of Rev. are requesting for RL license to host 30 events per year/ documented, to receive RL license. Discussion held as chose not to renew RL license, as may apply for Special Event License.

BUSINESS; Lawyer was in contact with Code Enforcer as Johnson requesting if Town Ordinance may cite residents not being in compliance with nuisance violations that Johnson has sent, as fine of \$150-500 a day may be assessed. Board requested if Code Enforcer was checking into Certified Auto specialist, for inspection of vehicles, tabled. Slowey (sewer) possible 10-14 day in advance as working in alley between Chicago and Dakota street as hoping all will be completed on milled streets, as working with contractor on asphaltting of some streets. Hydo clean will camera sewer for relining. Code Enforcer was in town August 14 and sent 6 letters to be in compliance by October 20. Clark outdoor buildings are being cleaned out for demolition. Mowing tax assessments were sent to BH Auditor along with Budget 2024-01. Lead Copper meters were completed and sent to State. Motion Bares, second Shrader for Chairperson to sign CDBG main st. disclosure of building removal. Motion carried. Request for Amendment extension of CDBG, tabled as lawyer to check with District III.

NEW BUSINESS: Flu Clinic is set for Thursday, Oct., 26 @ 9 am @ Community Center. Motion Shrader, second Neumayer to donate \$2000. To Rich Schild Firework. Motion carried. Sutera stated that possible Bluebirds may be working on reserving places around baseball field, for Rich Schild firework / baseball games.

MAINTENANCE; Lead Copper of meters completed and submitted. Working on fall cleanup of trees as some need to be removed in city right of way, as may get estimated for removal. Contacted Hartington Tree service as one tree died at Cimpl park and was given a replacement for free, as requested if we could purchase possible 20 plus trees. Motion Bares, second Shrader granted request for \$2500-3000. Motion carried. Asked if he should remove School signs on main street, as Board stated possible to get school bus stops in 4 areas. Someone removed 5 mph signs a Cimpl Park were removed the wk-end of Oct. 6-7. Will be gone Oct.27-30.

FINANCIAL: Building permits to Town n Country Pool. Water applications to Sam Caba, Leslie Himes. 15 late water notices sent with 6 2<sup>nd</sup> notices sent. Mark Povondra got Tabor website going; taborsd.city

Public comments: (3 minutes) Jerry Stibral read from his cell phone commentary. Board stated as we have heard the same comments for the last 3 months, as residents must abide by Ordinances. Requested whose terms will be up next year and when to file petitions. Lawyer stated FO publishes in Tyndal Paper.

FO received comment from Ambil as stated all ambulance reports have been sent to her on time.
